VISION LOSS & IMPAIRMENTS





SIGNS & SYMPTOMS IN INFANTS

- May have difficulty tracking/following objects
- May not have interest in objects, colours, or patterns
- May not reach for objects in front of them
- Cries or does not respond when exposed to bright lights

SIGNS & SYMPTOMS IN CHILDREN

- May appear clumsy or uncoordinated
- May have low attention span
- Squinting is common and complains of headache, double or blurred vision
- May sit too close to screens and whiteboards but still have difficulty reading properly





MAKING THEIR SPACE ACCESSIBLE

- Do NOT rearrange space often
 - Similar layout allows child to feel safe, comfortable and to know where things are
- Reduce tripping hazards & clutter
- Ensure good lighting and reduce glare
- Talk about and celebrate differences
 - o Put glasses on toys to increase their self-esteem

CLASSROOM TIPS

- Follow the child's goals and strategies document
 - Have child sit in class where they can best see
- Engage child's sense of touch and sound
- Use verbal aids to get their attention
 - Always use their names when talking to them
 - o Announce when you are leaving or entering the room
- Use closed captioning (audio description)





VISUAL AIDS

- Glasses
- Technology services (Ex. Talk to text)
- Braille (tactile writing system)
- Using a white cane or service animals (Ex. Guide dog for the blind)



PRACTICE GOOD EYE HABITS

- Position screens at least an arm's length away
- Take breaks to blink
- Adjust the lighting
- Limit screen use
